Rioja Alavesa - Spain <i>Intense garnet red with purple hints, fragrant nose with ripe berries and tomato leaf hints.</i>		
10. Marqués de Cáceres Reserva	C	£19.50
Rioja - Spain <i>Vivid dark ruby colour, intense bouquet of forest fruits and sweet spice. Good concentrations on the palate with delicious soft tannins. A very complex wine.</i>

New Zealand <i>Classic New Zealand Sauvignon fresh and zesty with grapefruit and herbaceous aromas and flavours.</i>		
22. Pouilly Fume 'Genetin' Vieilles Vignes	1	£18.50
Domaine Tinel-Blondelet - Loire - France <i>Full Sauvignon on the nose and a palate that is mouthfilling, round, and full of fruit.</i>		
23. Sancerre Domaine Serge Laporte	1	£18.50
Loire - France <i>This Sancerre stands out for its aromatic intensity, citrus, exotic fruits and minerality. A perfect balance between softness and acidity.</i>

Ropiteau - Burgundy - France <i>Creamy Chardonnay with mineral and flint flavours, well-balanced acidity with hints of acacia and honeysuckle.</i>
